When I wrote the article, I thought I was reviewing and re-enforcing current policy and not changing it. I never would have instituted a change in a school-wide policy in the middle of the year. There are varying opinions among both parents and staff regarding policy and practice of the after-school use of the playground. I reached out to Mrs. Sullivan and she shared that expectations have changed over time and that it is probably time to clarify the policy.

For the remainder of the year, feel free to continue with your current practice. I acknowledge and can see that this is a great connection time for families. I also have to acknowledge safety issues for all of the after-school groups of our students who utilize the playground. I want the same kind of safety for our students after school as during the day. It is a challenging balance. I will seek ways to find that balance, and we will clarify policy in the fall and then make practice align with policy.
